 - o List of any "Volunteer Work" participated in through high school years
 - Three (3) Character Reference Letters from non-relatives.
 - One (1) letter from a teacher, two (2) letters from someone outside of school, such as, neighbor, pastor, employer, etc.
 - Short essay explaining answers to the following questions:
 - What does the Community of Bremond mean to you?
 - What career choice are you considering and why?
 - Where do you plan to continue your education and why?
 - Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?
