1923 GLORIA STEPHAN SALE 1999



For almost 40 years, Gloria Stephan Sale ran the Bryan Coca-Cola Bottling Company with a strong hand and a keen wit. She was one of the first women to run a major business locally. When she died at age 75, Bryan-College Station lost a good friend. She wasn't open about her generosity, but her kindnesses over the years made life better for generations of local residents. Sale understood that success in business doesn't mean much if you aren't successful as a member of a community. She gave freely to many local organizations; particularly those that made life better for the children. She took over the Coca-Cola Bottling Company started in 1907 by her grandfather and father and, with the help of her beloved husband, E.B. "Chic" Sale; she pushed the business to new heights. And while she was tough, she also was fair. She had a soft spot in her heart for her employees and their families. Because she believed in paying forward into the future, she left three trusts: one for scholarships of regional students, another for the beautification of her town, Bryan, and a lastly, funds for her spiritual home, St. Andrews Episcopal Church. Gloria Stephan Sale left the community a far better place than she found it.
